Declaration of National Nature Reserve in the Parishes of Hatfield Broad Oak and Great Hallingbury in the County of Essex

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of section 19 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, that by the Hatfield Forest National Nature Reserve No. 1 Declaration 1994, made on 29th September 1994, the Nature Conservancy Council for England declared that the land containing 392.2 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parishes of Hatfield Broad Oak and Great Hallingbury in the county of Essex and shown coloured grey on the plan attached to the said Declaration, is being held by the National Trust, a body approved by the Council, and managed by it as a nature reserve.
