*The Borough of Stafford (Off-Street Parking Places) (Doxey Road Car Park, Stafford) Order 1994*

Notice is hereby given that on 30th September 1994, the Council made the above Order under section 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into operation on 1st October 1994, and will amend the existing parking arrangements at the Doxey Road Car Park, Stafford, to convert 368 long stay parking spaces to short stay on Saturdays only. The revised arrangements at the car park will be as set out in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Order and map relating thereto are available for inspection at the Town Clerk and Chief Executive's Office, Civic Offices, Riverside, Stafford, where they may be examined during normal office hours. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 30th September 1994, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
