

## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposed to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of highway at Hardwick Close, Holmewood, Chesterfield in the District of North East Derbyshire in the County of Derbyshire, commencing at the end of the existing footway on the south side of Hardwick Close for a distance of 8 metres in an easterly direction.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Cullen Carter and Hill by North East Derbyshire District Council on 4th December 1991, under ref. NED/1091/832.

The proposed Order will provide that the stopping up must not be carried out until the parking and manoeuvring areas have been provided to the reasonable satisfaction of North East Derbyshire District Council.

*The M25 Motorway (Heathrow Terminal 5 Access) Side Roads Order 19*

*The M4 Motorway (Junctions 3 to 4b Improvements, Heathrow Terminal Access) Side Roads Order 19*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, entitled the M25 Motorway (Heathrow Terminal 5 Access) Side Roads Order 19, in relation to the M25 Motorway situated between Junction 14 and the B3378 (Bath Road) in Hounslow in the London Borough of Hillingdon, which will:

(1) authorise him to:

- (a) stop up highways,
- (b) construct new highways,
- (c) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (d) provide new means of access to premises,

all at Hounslow in the London Borough of Hillingdon, at Staines in the Borough of Spelthorne, in the county of Surrey, and in the Parish of Colnbrook with Poyle, in the Borough of Slough, in the county of Berkshire on or in the vicinity of the route of the part of the Motorway mentioned above; and

(2) provide for the transfer of each new highway to the highway authority specified for it in the Order as from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for traffic.

2. An Order under sections 18 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, entitled the M4 Motorway (Junctions 3 to 4b Improvements, Heathrow Terminal 5 Access) Side Roads Order 19, in relation to the M4 Motorway situated between Junctions 3 and 4b in West Drayton and Hayes in the London Borough of Hillingdon and Hounslow in the London Borough of Hounslow, which will:

(1) authorise him to:

- (a) improve highways,
- (b) stop up highways,
- (c) construct new highways,
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises,

all at West Drayton and Hayes in the London Borough of Hillingdon and Hounslow in the London Borough of Hounslow on or in the vicinity of the route of the part of the Motorway mentioned above; and

(2) provide for the transfer of each new highway to the highway authority specified for it in the Order as from the date on which he notifies them that it has been completed and is open for traffic.
