Vienna, Dec. 27. On the 25th Baron Nimisch arrived here with the Barrier Treaty figned, for the Emperor's Ratification. Yesterday the two Ambassadors of Lucca had their Audience of the Emperor, wherein they complimented him on his Accellion to the Crown. They went to Court in a Coach with fix Horles, attended by two other Coaches, 4 Pages, 4 Heyduks, and re Footmen in rich Liveries : But they have not made * publick Entry, nor were they covered before the Emperor. This Day the feveral Ministers of Saxony Bave taken the Investitures for their Masters.

Ratisbon, Decemb. 4. Letters from Buda fay, The Imperial Regiments in Hungary had Order to pro-vide themfelves with every Thing neceffary for the Campaign, against next Spring. Letters from Rome of the 5th pair relate, that the Imperial Ambaffador folicited the Pope for a Brief of Eligibility to the Church of Munfler, in favour of the Elector of Trier; but that Affair was likely to be referred to the Confiltory, and to be united with a Brief of the fame Nature, which had been demanded in the Elector of Bavaria's Name, for the Church of Ratisbon, in favour of one of his Sons. Father Salerno a Jefuir, was ready to let out from Rome for Poland; the Substance of his Commission was faid to be, to em-

Journey for Italy as to Day: Hambourg, Dec. 10. Our laft Letters from the Camp before Stralfund are of the 7th and 8th Instant, adviling, that in the Night between the 3d and 4th the Swedes made a Sally, but with little effect. On the 4th fome Houfes in Stralfund were burnt, being fet on fire by Bombs thrown in, by the Beliegert. On the 5th in the Evening a Detachment commanded by Colleged Guldenfliern attacked the Counterferre by Collonel Guldenstiern attacked the Counterfcarp of the Hornwork, and after fome Refistance carried it, making 84 Swedes Pritoners; but the Lofs of the Befiegers in this Action was pretty confiderable. The Allies are now raifing Batteries on that Counterfcarp, in order to make Breaches in the Hornwork, and in the Body of the Place. On the 6th another Part of the Town was let on fire by the Beliegers Bombs, and feveral Houles were burnt down. The King or Sweden continues in Stralfund, and as Deferters we-port is continually buily in directing the making of Intrenchments within the Place. 'Tis faid his Majefty has ordered his' Fifcal to proceed against M. Trautfetter and Zulich, for fuffering the Intrench-ment before the Town to be furprized, and not defending it better ' And that his Majelty has broke all the Officers who capitulated at Oldenfahr on the Illand of Rugen.

Bruffels, Le., II. On the 3d Inftant Count Rech-teren and M. Geldermalfen, two Deputies of the States General, arrived here from Antwerp: They were next Morning in Conference with Count Ka-nigfeck the Imperial Mninfter, about the Evacuation of the Towns to be given up to the Emperor after the Ratifications of the Barrier Treaty are exchanged, and it is faid his Imperial Majefty proposes to take all the Artillery and Stores of War belonging to the States General in those Towns, at the Price to be agreed on by the faid Ministers; who are also to accertain the Sum to be allowed by their High Mightineffes out of the annual Sublidy, as an Equivalent for the Revenues of the Lands given in Propriety by his Imperial Majefly to the States General for an Ex-tention of their Limits in Flanders. The News we have received from Vienna, of the Emperour's defigning the Duke of Lorrain for Governour of the Spanish Netherlands, and giving the Dutchy of Limit bourg to the Elector of Palatine, does not a little alarm us here.
