Notice of application for combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works and to abstract water.

Take notice that Northern Hydro Ltd. of Talbot Road, Manchester, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to impede the flow of the Afon Goedol by means of construction of a weir, at National Grid Ref. SH 6891 4433, west of the A496, near Blaenau Ffestiniog, Meirionnydd, and to abstract water at the following rates, 5,760 cubic metres per hour, 138,240 cubic metres per day, 28,760,332 cubic metres per year, between 1st January and 31st December each year at or near that point. COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949

The Borough of Port Talbot acting in their capacity as coast protection authority, hereby give notice under subsection (i) of section 5 of the above Act, that they propose to carry out coast protection work as described herein at Aberavon Beach, Port Talbot.

The Phase 1 work will consist of the construction of a rock armour breakwater together with rock armour and asphaltic revetments to the existing sea wall.

The estimated cost of the work is £3 million.
