BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

North Bedfordshire Borough Council (Various Roads, Bedford) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Consolidation Order 1992, Amendment No. 1/1995.

Notice is hereby given that the Bedford Borough Council acting as agents for the Bedfordshire County Council as highway authority, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time in the following length of road:

Kempston Road, Bedford, on both sides, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Victoria Road to its junction with Prebend Street

and to prohibit the loading and unloading of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

Bedford Borough Council (Warwick Avenue, Bedford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1995
