

8. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the permitted hours for longer than the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge an additional amount of £20 (which additional amount is hereinafter referred to as the "excess charge") shall be payable.
- (2) (c) a statement that an excess charge of £20 is required to be paid.
