

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a length of highway at Rose Close, St. Anns, Nottingham, commencing at the western boundary of No. 79 Rose Close for a distance of 21 metres to the eastern boundary of No. 83 Rose Close.
