BARNSELY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Off-street Parking Places) (Alhambra Centre, Barnsley) Order 1991 (Amendment No.) Order 1991 .

Notice is hereby given that the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council propose to make an Order under the provisions of sections 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the proposed Order will be to include the area known as the Alhambra Service Area, off Lambra Road thereby making that area subject to the provisions of the Order, and to introduce 3 no parking bays within that area for use by holders of valid Alhambra Centre parking permits only.

BARNSELY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley (Goldthorpe, Thurnscoe and Bolton-on-Dearne) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 1987 (Amendment No. 3) Order 1995.

Notice is hereby given that on 14th February 1995, the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council made an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on 20th February 1995, will be to prohibit vehicles waiting at any time on part of both sides of the newly constructed Town Centre Link Road at Goldthorpe which extends from Barnsley Road for 105 metres; and at its junction with Railway Terrace.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking-up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and services therein, the pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets. The usual exceptions for disabled persons' vehicles are also included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted road may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of:

- (i) the Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, Town Hall, Barnsley, and
- (ii) The Branch Library, Barnsley Road, Goldthorpe.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 17th February 1995, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Hampshire (Borough of Basingstoke and Deane) (Parking Places) (Seal Road) Order 1995
