The application is to abstract water from the Dog Drain at N.G.R. SK 17910928 at Fisherwick Park Farm, Staffordshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 27 cubic metres per hour, 654 cubic metres per day, 10,000 cubic metres per year between November and March each year. The water will be used for transfer to a reservoir for subsequent irrigation under Licence 3/28/22/57/G. ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

Avon County Council (Newry Walk and Tavistock Road, Knowle West, City of Bristol) (Southern Zone) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- to prohibit any vehicle, except pedal cycles, entering, proceeding or waiting in that length of Newry Walk which extends from Daventry Road, south-eastwards for 2.5 metres.
- to consolidate the provisions of the "County Council of Avon (Tavistock Road, Knowle, City of Bristol) (Southern Zone) (Prohibition of Driving) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1990", omitting the exemption for emergency vehicles which currently applies to the closure on that length of Tavistock Road which extends from Daventry Road, south-eastwards for a distance of 2.5 metres. The only exemption remaining in respect of this closure will be for pedal cycles.
