- C144 Lees Road, Birchover, from a point 190 metres north-east of its junction with Birchover Road, Birchover, to that junction. Birchover Road, Birchover and Stanton, from its junction with
- C144 Lees Road, in a northerly direction to its junction with Pilhough Lane, Stanton-in-Peak.

- Pilhough Lane, Stanton, from its junction with Birchover Road, Stanton-in-Peak to its junction with C287 Stantonhall Lane
- C287 Stantonhall Lane, Stanton and Nether Haddon, from its junction with Pilhough Lane to a point 190 metres south-east of its junction with A6(T).

- C287 Stantonhall Lane, Stanton and Nether Haddon, from a point 190 metres south-east of its junction with the A6(T) to that junction.
- $A\delta(T)$  Nether Haddon and Rowsley, from its junction with C287 Stantonhall Lane, to its junction with Woodhouse Lane/School Lane. Rowsley.
