The Proposed Weymouth and Portland (Marina) Harbour Revision Order

Notice is hereby given that a Public Inquiry in connection with the proposed Weymouth and Portland (Marina) Harbour Revision Order will be held by W. J. Bingham (a person appointed by the Secretary of State for that purpose) at the Committee Room Number 2, Municipal Offices, Weymouth and Portland Borough Council, North Quay, Weymouth, Dorset DT1 8TA, commencing on Tuesday, 23rd May 1995, at 10 a.m. when representations from

persons who have objected to the draft Order, and from any other persons who wish to appear, will be heard.

The object of the proposed Order is to permit the Harbour Authority to grant a lease or leases of part of the Inner Harbour defined on the plan accompanying the draft Order for the development of a marina.

The applicants have proposed a slight reduction to the area to which the Order would relate. They have prepared a revised plan.
