Notice of proposals for varying a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region, in pursuance of section 52 of the Act, have formulated proposals for varying the licence (serial number 6/33/44/S/236) to abstract water from a tributary of the River Thet, at National Grid Reference TM067921, in the parish of Old Buckenham, in the district of Breckland, in the county of Norfolk.

The proposed variation is as follows:

- to include the on-stream reservoir at National Grid Reference TM065925 as a second source of supply;
- to authorise abstraction from the reservoir of up to 352 cubic metres per hour, 8,456 cubic metres per day and 28,240 cubic metres per year between 24th March and 30th September each year;

- to change the authorised period of abstraction from the first source of supply (a tributary of the River Thet) to between 1st November and 23rd March following each year;
- to require abstraction from the reservoir to be metered.

The purpose of the variation is to correct deficiencies in the original licence.
