Take notice that W. H. Knights & Sons, of Crow Hall Farm, Gooderstone, King's Lynn, Norfolk, is applying to the National Rivers Authority to vary licence serial No. 6/33/48/G/67 to abstract water from a chalk borehole at National Grid Reference TF768022 at Crow Hall Farm in the parish of Gooderstone, in the district of Breckland, in the county of Norfolk. The variation being applied for is to increase the quantities authorised to be abstracted from 33,186 cubic metres per year, 90.9 cubic metres a day and 9.09 cubic metres per hour to 146,290 cubic metres per year, 487.6 cubic metres a day and 81 cubic metres per hour and to extend the period of abstraction
