Notice is hereby given that Fenland District Council designated amendments to the above-named Conservation Area on 19th January 1995.

A plan of the Wisbech Conservation Area is available for public inspection during office hours at the Directorate of Development and Leisure Services, Fenland Hall, County Road, March, Cambridgeshire PE15 8NQ. The designation extends the Conservation Area in Blackfriars Road to include the Empire Theatre, along North Brink to include the remainder of Elgoods Brewery and small areas in South Brink, Alexandra Road and Norfolk Street.

The designation also deletes some areas previously contained within the Conservation Area namely, Horsefair, Albion Place, Somers Court and minor adjustments in North Brink and Chapel Road.

Through its designation the District Council seeks to ensure the preservation and enhancement of the character and appearance of the Conservation Area. Proposals for the demolition of any building or structure, or part thereof, will require Conservation Area consent from the District Council. For works to be carried out to trees, notice of 6 weeks will need to be given prior to the commencement of the works.
