

## DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dyfed (Cromwell Road, Milford Haven)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given that on 2nd May 1995, the Dyfed County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of this Order is to prohibit waiting at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order contains the usual exemptions including the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading or unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to the length of road affected by the Order. In addition the Order contains the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme.

The Order will come into operation on 22nd May 1995, and a copy of the Order, together with a map, indicating the length of road affected, may be inspected at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## FAREHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

*Borough of Fareham (Cornaway Lane/White Hart Lane/Sandport Grove/Cranleigh Road/Central Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 9) Order 1995.*

Notice is hereby given, that Fareham Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

1. To Prohibit Waiting in the following lengths of roads:
  - (a) Cornaway Lane, on both sides from a point opposite the northern boundary of No. 40 Cornaway Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 133 metres to its junction with White Hart Lane.
  - (b) Cornaway Lane Service Road (to Nos. 48-66 Cornaway Lane), on both sides from its junction with Cornaway Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 40 metres to a point opposite the northern boundary of No. 56 Cornaway Lane.
  - (c) White Hart Lane, on both sides from its junction with Cornaway Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 44 metres.
  - (d) Sandport Grove, on both sides from its junction with White Hart Lane in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres (the northern boundary of No. 2 Sandport Grove).
  - (e) Cranleigh Road, on the north side from its junction with Cornaway Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 18 metres.
  - (f) Cranleigh Road, on the south side from its junction with Sandport Grove in a westerly direction for a distance of 24 metres (the western boundary of No. 10 Cranleigh Road).
  - (g) Central Road, on both sides from its junction with Cornaway Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 46 metres to a point opposite the western boundary of No. 1 Central Road.

2. To Prohibit Waiting Monday to Saturday, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. inclusive, in the following length of road:

Cornaway Lane Service Road (to Nos. 48-66 Cornaway Lane) on the west side from a point opposite the northern boundary of No. 56 Cornaway Lane in a southerly direction and around the turning head for a distance of approximately 43 metres to include the southern end.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the roads concerned together with a statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the Chief Engineer, at the Civic Offices, Civic Way, Fareham, during usual office hours.

*Borough of Fareham (Various Roads, Portchester) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 11) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given, that Fareham Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

1. To Prohibit Waiting in the following lengths of roads:
  - (a) West Street, on the south side from the eastern boundary of Corner House in a westerly direction for a distance of 45 metres to the eastern boundary of No. 168 West Street.
  - (b) Westlands Grove, on both sides from its junction with West Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
  - (c) Hill Road, on both sides from the northern boundary of No. 35 Hill Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 64 metres to the northern boundary of No. 23 Hill Road.
  - (d) Portsview Avenue, on the north side from its junction with Hill Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 61 metres to the western boundary of No. 68 Portsview Avenue.
  - (e) Portsview Avenue, on the south side from its junction with Hill Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 58 metres to a point opposite the western boundary of No. 68 Portsview Avenue.

*Borough of Fareham (Various Roads, Fareham) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 10) Order 1995*

Notice is hereby given, that Fareham Borough Council propose to make the above-named Order pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be:

1. To Prohibit Waiting in the following lengths of roads:
  - (a) Blackbrook Park Avenue, on both sides from a point 20 metres west of its junction with The Avenue in an easterly then northerly direction around the bend for a distance of 70 metres.
  - (b) Leigh Road, on the south side from a point 98 metres east of its junction with Arundel Drive in an easterly direction around the bend for a distance of 79 metres to the northern boundary of No. 48 Leigh Road.
  - (c) The Causeway, on the north side from its junction with Down End Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.
  - (d) The Causeway, on the south side from its junction with Down End Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.
