- (a) to carry out the improvement of highways,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road comprising a length of highway which is to be a highway maintainable at the public expense which the Council are proposing to construct from a point 63 metres east of the centre line of the existing roundabout at the junction of Melton Road, Rearsby Road and the Syston Northern Bypass (A607) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 3184 metres to a point on Melton Road (A607) as proposed to be improved at its junction with the access to Brooksby Grange Farm in the Parishes of Queniborough, Rearsby and Hoby with Rotherby in the county of Leicestershire.

*Petty Sessional Division of Brecon and Radnor**Stopping-up of Public Rights and of Vehicular Rights at Ditch Hill Bridge improvement on the B4326 Walton to Presteigne Road*

Notice is hereby given that application will be made to the Magistrates for the Petty Sessional Division of Brecon and Radnor sitting at the Magistrates' Court, The High Street, Llandrindod Wells, on Wednesday, 30th August 1995, at 10.30 a.m. that a certain part of the Highway known as the B4362 Walton to Presteigne Road at Ditch Hill Bridge improvement should be stopped up as unnecessary:

- (a) Insofar as an area to the north-west of the junction of the Evenjobb Road with the Walton to Presteigne Road that all public rights should be extinguished.
