3. making any application other than an application for leave as required by section 42 of the said Act in any civil proceedings instituted in any Court by any person unless James Luke Blackstone obtains the leave of the High Court having satisfied the High Court that the proceedings or application are not an abuse of process of the Court in question and that there are reasonable grounds for the proceedings or application.
