Stafford – Uttoxeter Road A518 at Grindley Stopping-Up of part of former highway near Grindley House, Grindley

Notice is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council intend to apply to the Mid-Staffordshire Magistrates' court sitting at The Court House, South Walls, Stafford on the 16th October 1995 at 2 p.m. for an Order that part of the superseded section of the A518 Stafford – Uttoxeter road near Grindley House, Grindley and amounting to 2,385 square metres be authorised to be stopped up on the ground that it is unnecessary, subject to the reservation of a public footpath over this length.

The following persons have the right to be heard at the Hearing of the Council's application:

- (i) Any person upon whom this Notice has been served.
- (ii) Any person who uses the highway.
- (iii) Any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for.

A plan showing the length of highway to be stopped up has been deposited at the office of the County Clerk and Chief Executive, Staffordshire County Council, County Buildings, Martin Street, Stafford and at the Uttoxeter Library, "Red Gables", High Street, Uttoxeter and may be inspected at either of these places, free of charge, at all reasonable hours during work days.

BOMBARDIER PRORAIL LIMITED
TRANSPORT AND WORKS ACT 1992*Forge Lane Horbury Level Crossing Order*

Notice is hereby given that Bombardier Prorail Limited, Horbury, Wakefield, WF4 5QH ("the applicant") has made application to the Secretary of State for Transport, c/o Department of Transport, TWA Branch, P2/025A, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, for an Order under section [1][3] of the above mentioned Act to authorise "the construction and power to operate and use a new level crossing in addition to regularising an existing level crossing over the highway known as Forge Lane, Horbury, near Wakefield. The works consist of laying two rails and the construction of gates over Forge Lane to create the second new level crossing adjacent to the existing level crossing".

Any person wishing to object to the Order must do so in writing addressed to the Secretary of State at the above mentioned address, stating the grounds of the objection and the objector's name and address. The expiry date for making objections to the Order is 10th August 1994.
