CHESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Cheshire County Council (A533 Northwich Road, Dutton, Vale Royal Borough) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1995

The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Thanet) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1995.

Notice is hereby given that Kent County Council propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

Roads in Margate: Addington Road, Addington Square (East), Addington Street, Addiscombe Road, Alma Road, Bath Road, College Road, Cornwall Gardens, Cowper Road, Dane Hill, Dane Road, Danesmead Terrace, Devonshire Gardens, Drapers Avenue, Drapers Close, Grosvenor Hill, Grotto Hill, High Street, Laleham Gardens, Lister Road, Lower Northdown Avenue, Lyndhurst Avenue, Mansion Street, Norfolk Road, Northdown Avenue, Park Place, Princes Avenue, Queens Avenue, Ramsgate Road, Royal Crescent, St. Peters Road, Sussex Avenue, The Rendezvous, Tivoli Road, Upper Grove, Victoria Road.
