(13) <i>Tarran Way North</i>	North side, from a point 13.7 metres west of the west side of its junction with <i>Tarran Way East</i> to a point 13.7 metres east of the east side of its junction with <i>Tarran Way East</i> .
(14) <i>Tarran Way North</i>	North side, from its junction with <i>Pasture Road</i> for a distance of 13.7 metres in a westerly direction.
(15) <i>Pasture Road</i>	West side, from a point 487.4 metres north of the north side of its junction with <i>Pasture Avenue</i> to a point 13.7 metres north of the north side of its junction with <i>Tarran Way North</i> .
