*The A487 Trunk Road (North Road, Caernarfon, Gwynedd)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 199*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit and restrict waiting on the sides of the A487 Fishguard-Bangor Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as "trunk road") described in the Schedule to this notice. The proposed Order differs from the one advertised on 3rd February 1995 in that waiting will be restricted and not prohibited on the side of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.

Copies of the proposed Order, plan and statement of reasons for the making of the proposed Order may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at the offices of Gwynedd County Council, County Offices, Caernarfon, Gwynedd and may be obtained free of charge from the address below, quoting the Welsh Office reference during a period of 21 days from 22nd September 1995.

Objections, specifying the grounds on which they are made, and quoting reference ZC 510-2-4-91, must be sent in writing to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, by 13th October 1995. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection of representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

SCHEDULES

(All distances are approximate.)

Sides of the trunk road known as North Road, at Caernarfon in the county of Gwynedd.

SCHEDULE 1

No Waiting At Any Time

That length of the north-western side of the trunk road which extends from a point 24 metres north-east of the centrepoint of St. Davids Road Roundabout to a point 44 metres north-east of the centrepoint of its junction with Warfield Road.

That length of the south-eastern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 28 metres north-east of the centrepoint of St. Davids Road Roundabout in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 19 metres.

That length of the south-eastern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 115 metres north-east of the centrepoint of St. Davids Road Roundabout to a point 44 metres north-east of the centrepoint of its junction with Warfield Road.

SCHEDULE 2

No Waiting Between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Friday

That length of the south-eastern side of the trunk road which extends from a point 47 metres north-east of the centrepoint of St. Davids Road Roundabout in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 68 metres. (481)
