The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 17) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of Denton Hall, he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Essex) (No. 17) Order 1995" authorising the stopping-up of part of Blyth's Meadow, Braintree to enable the development consisting of emolition of two existing buildings, extension of ground floor sales area, existing unloading bay and change of use of bulkstock area and creation of new loading bay, extension of first floor to form enlarged dining area and amalgamation of existing car parks to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to J Sainsbury ple by Braintree District Council on 11th July 1995 under Ref. 94/01476/FUL.

of 2nd October 1995, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.
