SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of Waiting at any time

- (a) That length of the north-eastern side of the Chippenham car parks access road from its junction with Monnow Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
- (b) That the length of the north-eastern side of the Chippenham car parks access road from a point 29 metres south-east of its junction with Monnow Street in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- (c) That length of the north-eastern and then north-western side of the Chippenham car parks access road from a point 65 metres south-east of its junction with Monnow Street in a south-easterly direction and then a north-easterly direction for its entire length.
