Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of his powers under section 73 and 74 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf has made the above-named Order which came into operation on 8th September 1995.

The effect of the Order is that until 4th March 1996, there will be modifications to the restrictions to which the Company is subject in respect of the abstraction of water from the River Hayle under the provisions of Licence to Abstract Water Number 15/49/252/S/22. The modification is that for a period not exceeding six months the prescribed flow in the River Hayle is reduced from 0.222 cubic metres per second (4.22 million gallons per day) to 0.105 cubic metres per second (2.0 million gallons per day).
