TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Proposed Stopping-up of Part of a Rear Access Road at Huyton, Knowsley

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of part of an unnamed access road to the rear of shops 44-78 Woolfall Heath Avenue, Huyton, Knowsley.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council, on 9th June 1995, under ref. APP/95/00326.
