Bedfordshire County Council propose to remove the 30 m.p.h. speed limit on part of Bedford Road, Cople (A603)

Notice is hereby given that Bedfordshire County Council proposes to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order as follows:

Effect of the Order: To remove the 30 m.p.h. speed limit imposed by the installation of a system of street lighting on the following length of road:

Royal County of Berkshire (Reeds Hill Area, Bracknell) (Prohibition of Waiting)

Royal County of Berkshire (B3034 Forest Road, Terrace Road South and St. Marks Road, Binfield) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1995.

Notice is hereby given that, the County Council of the Royal County of Berkshire proposes to make an Order under sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to:

(a) prohibit any vehicle from proceeding at a speed greater than 40 m.p.h. along the following lengths of road:

B3034 Forest Road, from a point 75 metres west of its junction with the B3018 Church Lane, to a point 435 metres west of that point; and
