TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Hampshire) (No. 10) Order 1995", authorising the stopping-up of highway land at Hamilton Close, Houndmills, Basingstoke, in the county of Hampshire.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Derby City Council he proposes to make an Order under section 249 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on an irregularly shaped area of highway at Portland Street, Derby, at the junction

with Pear Tree Road, measuring 700 square metres, adjacent to the Baptist Church and Library.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
 - (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) in connection with weddings and funerals at Peartree Baptist Church;
- and for use by pedal cyclists.

During 28 days from 6th November 1995 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the offices of the City Secretary's Department, Derby City Council, The Council House, Corporation Street, Derby, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Secretary of State at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days, any person may by notice to the Secretary of State, Government Office for the East Midlands, Transport and Planning Division (Ref. EMCM 5050/41/39/07), The Belgrave Centre, Stanley Place, Talbot Street, Nottingham NG1 5GG, object to the making of the Order.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Derbyshire) (No. 8) Order 1995", authorising the stopping-up of a length of highway at Austin Street, Shirebrook, Derbyshire, commencing at a point 43 metres north-west of the junction with Manvers Street in a north-westerly direction for 22 metres.
