*The Isle of Wight Council (Various Streets, Chale, Isle of Wight)
(Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1995*

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To revoke "The Isle of Wight County Council (Various Streets, Chale, Isle of Wight) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1982".
2. To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order subject to the following amendments:

To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Chale Street, Chale (B3339) on the west side, from the junction with A3055 Military Road to a point 150 feet north thereof;

Chale Street, Chale (B3339) on the east side, from the junction with A3055 Military Road to a point 75 feet north thereof.

The Order is designed to reduce congestion and delay in the said roads and to facilitate the free flow of traffic generally in the promotion of road safety.

A copy of the draft Order, this notice and the relevant plan may be inspected between normal office hours at the Customer Service Centre, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight, during the objection period. If you wish to object to the proposed restrictions contained in this notice you should send the grounds for your objection, in writing, to the undersigned not later than 12 noon on 1st December 1995.

Notice is hereby given that the Isle of Wight Council in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be as follows:

1. To revoke "The Isle of Wight County Council (Various Streets, Freshwater, Isle of Wight) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1994".
2. To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order subject to the following amendments:

To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Brookside Road, on the north-west side, from a point 150 feet south-west to a point 200 feet south-west of the junction with Moa Place;

Golden Ridge, on both sides, from the junction with High Street to a point 60 feet east thereof;

Guyers Road, on both sides, from the junction with Victoria Road to a point 60 feet south of the junction with Selwood Road;

Heathfield Road, on the east side, from the junction with St. Andrews Way to a point 150 feet north thereof;

Hook Hill, on the north-west side, from a point 50 feet north-east of the junction with School Green Road to a point 45 feet north-east of the junction with The Crundles;

Princes Road, on the west side, from the junction with The Avenue to the junction with Elm Close;

Princes Road, on the west side, from a point 40 feet north of the junction with Elm Close to a point 30 feet north of the junction with Richmond Meade;

Princes Road, on the east side, from a point 140 feet north of the junction with Avenue Road to a point 30 feet north of the junction with Richmond Meade.

To limit the waiting of vehicles to 1 hour in any 2, between 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays in the following lengths of road:

School Green Road, on the north side, from a point 300 feet east to a point 500 feet east of the access road to Freshwater All Saints School;
