Stopping-up of lengths of Colebrooke Lane, Cullompton, Devon

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 248 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Devon) (No. SW 12) Order 1995" authorising the stopping-up lengths of Colebrooke Lane, Cullompton, Devon, to enable development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission referred to in that Schedule and requiring the provision of new footpaths along the routes to be closed.
