TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of an irregularly shaped area of highway at East Moor, Cotgrave, Nottinghamshire, measuring 280 square metres, adjacent to the north-western boundary of No. 28 East Moor.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with deemed planning permission granted by Rushcliffe Borough Council on 12th January 1994, under reference 93/01165/REG3.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
