WATER RESOURCES ACT 1991

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority—Thames Region by The Sutton District Water Plc of 59 Gander Green Lane, Cheam, Sutton, Surrey to vary the licence (serial number 28/39/41/14) to abstract water from the underground chalk strata at New Road, Mitcham Junction, Surrey (boreholes grouped at National Grid Reference TQ 280 663).

The variation applied for is to change the authorisation from industrial processes (i) cooling, (ii) manufacture, and (iii) welfare, to public water supply.

No increase in the maximum annual quantities previously authorised is now sought.

Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Flintoff & Son, of Crakehill, Sessay, Thirsk, North Yorkshire YO7 3NS, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from the River Swale between National Grid Reference Points SE42697358 and SE43237211 and Crakehill Beck, between National Grid Reference Points SE43077379 and SE43517387 at Crakehill in the Parish of Edmire with Crakehill, Hambleton district of North Yorkshire. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rate: in aggregate from both sources, 30 cubic metres per hour, 422 cubic metres per day, 12,500 cubic metres between 1st April and 30th September each year. Downham, of Carus Green Golf Club, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from man made pond at National Grid Reference SD51609509 at Carus Green Golf Course, Burneside Road, Kendal. The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates: 27.5 cubic metres per hour, 27.5 cubic metres per day, 2,280 cubic metres per year between 1st April and 31st October each year. The water will be used for spray irrigation of Carus Green Golf Course.
