Notice of application for a licence to abstract water

Take notice that Wilfred Maddocks Ltd., of Chadwell Grange, Newport, Shropshire TF10 9BG, is applying to the National Rivers Authority for a licence to abstract water from the Lynn Brook between National Grid References SJ78761506 and SJ78841407 and from the Dawford Brook between National Grid References SJ78911554 and SJ79441464 at Chadwell Grange, Newport, Shropshire, in the parish of Blymhill in the district of South Staffordshire.

The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates:

109 cubic metres per hour, 2,618 cubic metres per day and 100,000 cubic metres per year between November and March each year. These quantities are the total amount to be abstracted from the two streams which are both tributaries of the Back Brook (sometimes known as the Stockton Brook). The water will be used to fill irrigation reservoirs and for subsequent spray irrigation.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BOURNEMOUTH BOROUGH COUNCIL

*(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981 (Variation)
(No. 9) Order 1995 (Part 1)*

Bournemouth Borough Council acting as agent to Dorset County Council, has made the above named Order on 4th January 1996. The Order has been made by virtue of Regulation 25, "Making Orders in Part", of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1989. The Order becomes effective on 15th January 1996. The notice of proposals was published in issue No. 54203 on Monday, 6th November 1995 under Ref. No. 590. The Order has been made as published with the exception of the provisions for Dunkeld Road, Nairn Road and Wallisdown Road (northern side from 20 metres east of the centre line of Alton Road to 143 metres west of the centre line of Slades Lane and from 114 metres east of Slades Lane to White Farm Close), on which

provisions the Council has deferred making a decision on whether to make an order under the said Regulation 25.
