The effect of the designation of the Conservation Area may be summarised as follows:

- (a) Where any application for Planning Permission for development of land in the Conservation Area is made to the local planning authority, it is the duty of the local planning authority to pay special attention to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the area.
- (b) Anyone wishing to demolish a building or a part of a building situate within the Conservation Area must firstly apply for consent to demolition to the local planning authority. This is not taken to be included in a planning permission for redevelopment of the site. Some buildings may be exempt from this requirement.

(c) Anyone wishing to cut down, top, lop or uproot a tree situated within the Conservation Area must give 6 weeks prior notice of his/her intention to the Local Planning Authority.

(d) Certain types of minor developments which would normally be permitted under the terms of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, and certain types of advertisements which would normally have deemed consent under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992, may not be carried out or displayed (as the case may be) unless an application to the local planning authority has been granted.

A map of the Conservation Area may be inspected, free of charge, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays at the Corporation's offices, Trafford Wharf Road, Wharfside, Trafford Park, Manchester, or at Planning Reception, Trafford Town Hall, Talbot Road, Stretford.

Provision of Road Humps in Beavers Lane, Barrack Road and Martindale Road, Hounslow West

The speed cushions would be arranged in pairs measuring 1-6 metres wide, 1-8 metres long and 75 millmetres high. They would be of pre-cast concrete construction.
