North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting) (Various Roads, Reeth) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given, that North Yorkshire County Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from waiting (except for certain exempted purposes, including the loading and unloading of goods) at any time on any length of road specified in Part I the following table and revoke the Traffic Regulation order specified in Column 1 of Part II of the following table to the extent specified or referred to in Column 2 of that part of that table.

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991 SECTION 58 (ENGLAND AND WALES) OR SECTION 117 (SCOTLAND)

Notice of Substantial Road Works (England and Wales)

Notice of Substantial Works for Road Purposes (Scotland)

Three months notice is hereby given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to carry out the substantial road works at the locations specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. The street/road in which these works will take place as specified in the said Schedule.

3. Work is expected to affect the carriageway/footway/footpath verge as specified in the said Schedule.

4. Work is expected to commence on the corresponding dates specified in the said Schedule.

5. The area and extent of the Works notified are specified in the said Schedule.

6. Subject to the exceptions in the Act and Regulations under it no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5 without the consent of Hertfordshire County Council which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
