WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL

Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Amendment Order No. 29 1996

Notice is hereby given that Woking Borough Council with the consent of the County Council of Surrey, propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to regulate the use of the temporary car park on the site of the former Woking Victoria Hospital by applying the provisions of the Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 1978. New charges will also be applied for parking. These charges are shown in the Schedule to this Notice which together with the other details shown in the Schedule will amend the 1978 Order. Regulating the car park also has the added effect of applying the current excess charge provision, i.e. £15 if paid within 14 days of the issue of the excess charge notice and £40 if paid after 14 days, and applying penalties for other offences.
