Notice of Application to Vary a Licence to Abstract Water

Take notice that W. Raper & Son of Chapel Farm, North Kilvington, Thirsk, North Yorkshire YO7 4AE, is applying to the National Rivers Authority to vary licence serial number 2/27/23/52 to abstract water from Cod Beck at Chapel Farm in the Parishes of North Kilvington and Thornton-Le-Street, Hambleton District of North Yorkshire.
