## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

### BLACKPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Blackpool (Burwood Drive) (Residents Parking Places) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that Blackpool Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Lancashire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 46A, 49, 53, 124(1)(d) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make the above-mentioned Order.

The Order will have the following effects:

- (1) To designate the lengths and sides of road specified in the First Schedule to this notice as residents and visitor parking places.
- (2) To prohibit waiting at any time on the lengths and sides of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice.
- (3) (i) To enable residents in the respective road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice, who are owners of private motor vehicles, to purchase a residents' parking permit in the sum of £5 per year; and  
(ii) To enable residents in the respective road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice to purchase a visitors parking permit in the sum of £5 per year.  
(Households will be limited to one resident's and one visitor's parking permit).

Exemptions to the proposed No Waiting Order will permit vehicles to wait for the purposes of:

- (a) picking-up and setting-down passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading vehicles;
- (c) emergency service vehicles;

and where necessary in connection with:

- (d) the maintenance of the roads or services therein;
- (e) building operations, or demolition;
- (f) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
