The City of Salford (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) Order 1988 (Variation) Order No. 4 1996

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Salford propose to make the above mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. When the Order comes into effect, the City of Salford (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) Order 1988, as amended, will have

effect as though:

(a) The parking places specified in Schedule 1 to this Order were deleted in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Order of 1988.

(b) The road and directions specified in Part 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order is included in Schedule 3 to the Order of 1988.
(c) The road and directions specified in Part 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order is deleted in Schedule 3 to the Order of 1988.
