TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Stopping-up of a Highway at Failsworth, Oldham

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council, he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (Metropolitan Borough of Oldham) (No. 2) Order 1996" authorising the stopping-up of part of the southerly side of Brierley Avenue, Oldham, being the back area of the footway fronting No. 26 Brierley Avenue.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of 10th April 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of Cleveland (A179 Lancaster Road Diversion Hartlepool) (Side Roads) Order 1995

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the above Order which was made by the County Council of Cleveland under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to:

- (a) to carry out the improvements of highways;
 - (b) to stop up lengths of highways;
 - (c) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
 - (d) to provide new means of access to premises,
- all on or in the vicinity of the classified roads which are as follows:
- (i) the A179 which the Council proposes to construct from the northern spur of the Middleton Road roundabout in a
