

- A1.1 An area within Post Code Area EN4 comprising land on the southern side of Trent Park and including the following residential properties in Bramley Road: 1-7 (cons) Eastpole Cottages.
- A1.2 An area within Post Code Area EN2 comprising land on the south side of Enfield Road in the vicinity of South Lodge Crescent and Lakeside.
- A1.3 An area within Post Code Area EN2 comprising land to the west of The Ridgeway.
