

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58

Notice of Substantial Roadworks

Three months notice is hereby given that Hertfordshire County Council's Environment Department intends to carry out the substantial roadworks at the location specified below.

2. The street/road in which these works will take place is specified in the said Schedule.
3. The work is expected to affect the carriageway/footway/footpath/verge as specified in the said Schedule.
4. The work is expected to commence on the corresponding dates specified in the said Schedule.
5. The area and extent of the works notified are specified in the Schedule.
6. Subject to the exceptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5 without the consent of Hertfordshire County Council, Director of Environment, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

Notice of Substantial Road Works

Three months advance notice is hereby given that Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council intends to carry out substantial works for road purposes.

2. The streets in which these works will take place are A6(T) Buxton Road, High Lane, Stockport.

3. Work is expected to affect the carriageway, footway and verge between Middlewood Way Bridge and Middlewood Road, and Norwood Avenue to Russell Avenue.

4. Work is expected to commence on 1st July 1996. (Work should begin within one month of this date.)

5. The works notified will include the following: (a) full width of footway and carriageway; (b) carriageway and footway reconstruction including rekerbing and verge works.

6. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and Regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of twelve months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5, without the consent of Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
