CLEAN AIR ACT 1993**

Castle Morpeth Borough Council Smoke Control Order No. 6 1996

Notice is hereby given that it is the intention of the Borough of Castle Morpeth Council to exercise the power conferred on them by the above-mentioned Act to make an Order entitled The Castle Morpeth Borough Council Smoke Control Order No. 6 1996, declaring the area as described in the First Schedule hereto, to be a Smoke Control Area.

Subject to the exemption provided by the Order if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of the building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding level three of the standard scale, unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and any other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

The classes of fireplaces in the areas, which are specified in the Second Schedule hereto, shall be exempted.

The Order will not come into operation before 31st March 1997.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Council Offices, The Kylins, Morpeth NE61 2EQ, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday, during the period of 6 weeks from 21st May 1996.

The boundary commences at OS grid NU 243 015, then runs due east along the boundary with Alnwick District Council to OS grid point NU 247 014, then runs south-east to OS grid point NU 259 002. The boundary follows the A1068 south to OS grid point 255 985, then due west to OS grid point NZ 250 985, then north-west to OS grid point NU 242 012, then follows the boundary with Alnwick District Council north returning to OS grid point NU 243 015.
