DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Southway Drive Area, Southway, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting and Bus Stop Clearway) Amendment Order 1996.

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

1. to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on parts of Southway Drive but excluding the parking bays;
2. to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on parts of Clitaford Road, Flamborough Road and Pendeen Crescent;
3. to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m., Monday to Saturday on part of Flamborough Road;
4. to prohibit vehicles other than buses from waiting at any time on any day at any bus stop marked on parts of the entire length of Southway Drive and the carriageways at these stops area marked (a) as a bus stop and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway ("the authorised markings");
5. to revoke in their entirety The City of Plymouth (Southway Drive/Flamborough Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971 and The County of Devon (Southway Drive/Pendeen Crescent, Southway, Plymouth) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976;
6. to revoke part of Schedule 2 of The County of Devon (Ernesettle/Whitleigh/Southway/Tamerton Area, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting and One-way Traffic) Amendment Order 1984 and part of Schedule 1 of The County of Devon (Southway Drive/Pendeen Crescent, Plymouth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1994, full details of which are contained in the proposed Order.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks, the maintenance of essential services and for vehicles used by disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the orange badge scheme.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order relating to paragraph 4 above, permitting waiting at the bus stops with the authorised markings, where necessary:

- (a) for the removal of obstruction to traffic;

(b) in certain circumstances in exercise of statutory powers;

(c) in certain emergencies and

(d) for police, fire and rescue service and ambulance purposes.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours except between 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. at the address given below and at the Branch Library, 351 Southway Drive, Plymouth, during its opening hours.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Various Streets, Barnstaple) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1996

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make the above-named Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle, as defined in the Act, from proceeding in:

- (a) that length of Newport Road which extends from its junction with South Street and Hollowtree Road to its junction with Landkey Road;
- (b) that length of Landkey Road which extends from its junction with Newport Road to its junction with Cradleman's Cross; and
- (c) that length of Hollowtree Road which extends from its junction with Newport Road and South Street to its junction with Hughes Avenue.

The proposed Order will contain an exemption to permit heavy commercial vehicles to proceed in the above length of roads for specific purposes only.

Full details of the proposals, and the exemption, are contained in the draft Order which, together with a plan illustrating the lengths of roads concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected during normal office hours, Monday to Friday (except public holidays), at Room 402, Civic Centre, Barnstaple.

Objections to the proposals specifying the grounds on which they are made must be submitted in writing to The County Solicitor, Devon County Council, Civic Centre, Barnstaple, Devon EX31 1ED, to arrive by not later than 17th June 1996, quoting ref. D1851.
