#### *Notice of Application for Consent in Pursuance of Schedule 10*

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, that an application has been made to the Environment Agency, by Butterley Aggregates Ltd. for consent to discharge 2,500 cubic metres per day of trade effluent from Norton Disney Quarry, Norton Disney, Lincolnshire, into a tributary of the River Witham at National Grid Reference SK88156029 within the North Kesteven District Council area. The effluent will derive from the Company's dewatering operation for the purposes of prevention of interference with the extraction of sand/gravel at this site.

#### *Notice of Application for Consent for the Purposes of Section 88*

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Schedule 10 of the above Act that an application has been made to the Environment Agency by Mr. A. Stevens for consent to discharge up to 12.5 cubic metres per day of treated effluent via a sub-surface irrigation system to a tributary of the Preston Brook from The Royal Oak Inn, Much Marcle, Herefordshire HR8 2ND, at National Grid Reference SO66153425.

The treated sewage effluent will only be discharged to the watercourse following a prolonged period of wet weather when the capacity of the soakaway system has been fully utilised and it is unable to retain any further effluent.
