TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (London Borough of Wandsworth) (No. 2) Order 1996" authorising the stopping-up of the whole of Newtown Street south of Battersea Park Road and north of Strasburg Road, the whole of the north-eastern arm of Strasburg Road, a length and a part of the western footway of Strasburg Road, the whole of western footway and 2 parts of the un-named highway adjoining the eastern side of that length of Alfreda Street south of Battersea Park Road and north of Strasburg Road, 2 areas of highway land to the south of Battersea Park Road, the whole of the un-named footpath to the south and to the west of Bank Court and the whole of the un-named footpath on the western side of Park Court on the Doddington Estate, Battersea, London S.W.11, and requiring the provision of two new footpaths.
