

## BURNLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Burnley (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1996*

Notice is hereby given that on 27th June 1996, the Burnley Borough Council as agent of the Lancashire County Council made the above-mentioned Order under section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the effect of which is:

(a) To revoke the Borough of Burnley (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1995.

(b) To vary the charges for the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this notice.

The Schedule to this notice also shows the classes of vehicles, the days and times of operation, the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges for the car parks.

A copy of the Order, together with a site location plan may be examined at the office of the undersigned, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, on Mondays to Fridays inclusive between the hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

If you wish to question the validity of this Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with, you may within 6 weeks from 27th June 1996, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
