UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of Wadham College, Oxford on 7th August 1996, amending Statute VI, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The A483 Trunk Road (Crossgates, Powys) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 199

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will come into force on 27th August 1996.

The effect of the Order is to revoke, re-enact and update as necessary, the provisions of the Trunk Road (A483) (Crossgates, Powys) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1985.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; or that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act, he may, within 6 weeks of the 23rd August 1996, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or of any provision contained therein.
