

and the effect of that Order will be to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of the experimental Order as varied by the provisions of the variation Orders and as modified.

The roads affected by the permanent Order are Clifford Avenue, Kew Road and Mortlake Road in the London Borough of Richmond-upon-Thames and Upper Richmond Road in the London Boroughs of Richmond-upon-Thames and Wandsworth.

A copy of the permanent Order, a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and a copy of the experimental Order and any other Order revoked, suspended or varied by the permanent Order, can be inspected, during normal office hours, at the offices of the Traffic Director for London, College House, Great Peter Street,

London SW1P 3LN, London Borough of Wandsworth, Room 153, Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London SW18 2PU, and London Borough of Richmond-upon-Thames, Civic Centre, 44 York Street, Twickenham TW1 3BZ.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the permanent Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers, or that any of the relevant requirements have not been complied with in relation to that Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which that Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
