#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The Chester to Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Pont Dafydd to Waen Improvement, Detrunking) Order 1996*

*The Chester to Bangor Trunk Road (A55) (Pont Dafydd to Waen Improvement Side Roads) Order 1996*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road between Pont Dafydd and Waen in the county of Denbighshire, he has made the following Orders:

an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980 the effect of which is that a part width of the Chester-Bangor (A55) Trunk Road between Pont Dafydd and Waen shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the county of Denbighshire that the adjoining widened length of trunk road is open for through traffic;

an Order under sections 12, 14, 125 and 268 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the above-mentioned trunk road, and providing for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Denbighshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for use.

Copies of the Orders and of the relevant plans have been deposited at the Welsh Office Highways Directorate, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF1 3NQ and at Welsh Office Highways Directorate, Government Building, Dinerth Road, Colwyn Bay; Denbighshire County Council, County Hall, Mold; St. Asaph Public Library, The Roe, St. Asaph, where they are open to inspection, free of charge, at all reasonable hours.

Any person aggrieved by either of the Orders and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders, may, within 6 weeks from 11th September 1996, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Orders or of any provision contained therein.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

*Notice of Public Path Order, The Hall Road, Burnhope, Temporary Stopping-up and Diversion Order (No. 1) 1996*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 247, 253 and 261 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, proposes to make a temporary footpath Order if planning permission is granted by him to enable the extraction of minerals by surface working.

The effect of the Order will be to divert (A) Footpath No. 17 (Lanchester) and (B) Footpath No. 34 (Stanley) and stop up (C) part of Footpath No. 21 (Lanchester), all for a period of 18 months.

The lines and situation of the existing and proposed alternative highways are shown on the map annexed to the Order.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

*Public Path Order, The Hall Road, Burnhope, Temporary Stopping-up and Diversion (No. 1) Order 1996*

This Order is made by the Secretary of State for the Environment under sections 247, 253 and 261 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, because he is satisfied that:

- (a) it is necessary to stop-up and/or divert the footpaths to which this Order relates for the purpose of enabling minerals to be worked by surface working in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely Opencast Coal Extraction at Hall Road, Burnhope, Co. Durham; and
- (b) the footpaths can be restored after the minerals have been worked to a condition not substantially less convenient to the public.

By this Order:

1. The footpaths (A), (B) and (C) described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") and shown by bold black lines on the attached map shall be stopped-up and/or diverted as provided by this Order for a period of 18 months as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Durham County Council alternative footpaths in the situation and along the lines described in Part II of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes and dots on the attached map, for use as replacements for the footpaths referred to in Article 1 above during the said period.
3. The stopping-up and diversion of the footpaths referred to in Article 1 above shall have effect on the date on which it is certified by Durham County Council that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
4. Before the expiration of the said period the footpaths referred to in Article 1 above and described in Part I of the Schedule shall be reconstructed to a condition not substantially less convenient to the public than it was prior to the stopping-up or diversion.
5. At the expiration of the said period the footpaths referred to in Article 2 above and described in Part II of the Schedule shall be stopped up and the footpaths referred to in Article 1 above shall be restored to public use.
6. Hutchinson Mining is hereby required to pay the cost of carrying out the above-mentioned work.
7. Where immediately before the date on which the footpaths are stopped up and/or diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across them belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

- (A) Footpath 17 (Lanchester) to be diverted from point A on the attached map, 340 metres to the east of its junction with New Acres Road, for a distance of 420 metres east, to point B where the footpath joins Holmside Hall Road.
- (B) Footpath 34 (Stanley) to be diverted from point F on the attached map 460 metres south of its junction with Wagtail Lane, for a distance of 286 metres south to point G at its junction with footpath 20 (Lanchester).

- (A) Footpath 17 (Lanchester) to be diverted to a new line starting at point A on the attached map then running south-east for 240 metres, turning south along an existing hedgerow for a distance of 30 metres, then eastwards for 600 metres along the northern edge of the existing field boundary and hedgerow and turning north for 170 metres along the western edge of the existing hedgerow to join Holmside Hall Road at point C.
- (B) Footpath 34 (Stanley) to be diverted to a new line starting at point F on the attached map and running generally eastwards for 310 metres to point I and turning south for 310 metres to point H, at its junction with footpath 20 (Lanchester).

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984—SECTION 14

#### *The A13 Trunk Road (New Road, Havering) (Temporary Restriction of use of gap in Central Reservation) Order 1996*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order on the A13 Trunk Road in the London Borough of Havering because works are to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order is to close the central reservation gap on the A13 Trunk Road opposite its junction with South Street. In addition there will be a ban on U-turn movements on the A13 from the eastbound to the westbound direction opposite Lower Mardyke Avenue.

During the closure traffic wishing to turn right from South Street to A13 westbound will be diverted north along South Street, left to Lowen Road, left to Lower Mardyke Avenue, right to A13 westbound. Traffic wishing to turn right from A13 to South Street will be diverted right from A13 westbound to Lower Mardyke Avenue, right to Lowen Road, right to South Street. Traffic wishing to make a U-turn movement from A13 eastbound to westbound should continue eastbound to Dovers Corner roundabout then proceed westbound.

The closures and diversion routes will be clearly indicated by traffic signs throughout the works period.

The Order comes into force on 16th September 1996, and will be in operation for a maximum duration of 18 months.
